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### **PALMESANO ANNOUNCES SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY**

**Students must return completed applications to Palmesano's Office by Friday, April 14**

Assemblyman Phil Palmesano (R,C,I-Corning) and his fellow members of the Conference of Italian-American State Legislators are announcing the availability of applications for their annual scholarship program.

Four scholarships will be awarded, each totaling \$3,000. Two will be awarded based on academic achievement and two will be athletic scholarships.

Students must complete an application and submit it to Assemblyman Palmesano's office by the close of business on **Friday, April 14**.

"As the cost of a quality higher education continues to increase, scholarship programs like this one can be the big break a talented student needs to turn the dreams of a higher education into a reality. I'm encouraging students in my district to apply. It can mean a big savings for them and their families," said Palmesano.
